Demographic Information

Mr. John Doe is a 40-year-old White male who was born on @. John reported that his marital status is in a committed relationship and he is satisfied with his current marital status. He was born in Lincoln, NE and raised predominately in Elmwood, NE. John reported that he has lived at the address listed above for one year. John has identified his religious preference is none.

Presenting Problem/Primary Complaint

Mr. John Doe first was referred to have this assessment on 10/26/2020. He is receiving this evaluation primarily due to "He is trying to keep a felony off his record and concedes that he needs help to maintain his sobriety.". John says "Tired of losing everything that he has worked for, when he gets a little ahead drug use interferes." was his motivation to schedule this evaluation. @ of Lancaster Co Drug and Alcohol Court referred John for this assessment. He stated that he has not been in a controlled environment any of the past thirty days.

Medical History

Mr. John Doe reported that his general state of health is fair. John reports no significant pre-natal, birth or developmental problems. He reports having a history of serious injuries,

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illnesses, physical disabilities or handicapping conditions as follows: Broke ankle when 15 bum knee and shoulder. John reports he has been hospitalized two times. He stated the last time hospitalized was in 07/2017 for Appendix burst. He reports having no current medical conditions that interfere or impact his life. He is not taking any prescribed medication for a medical (not psychiatric) problem. John said he receives no financial compensation or disability payments for a physical disability. John reports that he has fathered no children. He reports that he has been tested for HIV/AIDS and then did receive the results and was last tested in 2019. John stated that his primary care physician/family doctor is none at this time. The date of his most recent medical exam was in 2015.

John has not experienced any medical problems during the past thirty days. John reported he has been not at all worried or bothered about physical health in the past thirty days. He sees no need for physical health consultation or treatment.

School/Work/Military History

Mr. John Doe reported that he has completed his less than 12 years of schooling for the following reason: Figured he could make more money working than going to school. He attended @ High School. He was not in any special education program. After high school he attended no further training. John identified Pool Builder and Hood Cleaner, Construction worker as his professional skills and/or trade. For most of the past three years, 18 months or more, he has been employed full time. In his lifetime his longest full-time employment has been seven years at @ with a job title/position of Ranger. John 's estimated gross income for the past calendar year was \$25,000.00. He identified his current employment status as employed full time at @ with a job title/position of Pool Builder. He is paid \$15.00 per hour and he has been paid for working nine days in the past 30 days.

John reports the following as additional support: Girlfriend. This support does not constitute the majority of his monthly financial support. No one else relies on him for support. John does have a valid driver's license at this time and does have an automobile available to use. He has never been a member of the Armed Services.

John reports that he has not experienced any days of school or job-related problems in the past 30 days. John has been slightly worried or bothered about school or employment problems in the past thirty days due to need to get a winter job. He sees no need for school, career or employment counseling.

He started using cannabis at age 15. He would smoke on the weekends a couple joints a day. This increased to daily at age 16, where he would smoke every day 3 joints/bowls a day. When he was 18 it increased to consistent use where he was stoned all day. When he moved out of stat three years ago, he did not smoke for about a year.

Since July he has been trying to stay away from it but reported that he inadvertently used a pipe with Meth residue.

John reported that he has experienced withdrawal from a substance and explains Meth and tobacco. Withdrawal from Meth would feel that he had no energy and would be moody. He says that he is currently abstinent from the primary drug of choice. John reports that the last period of abstinence was one year and the last period of abstinence ended November 5th, 2020 ago. John reports spending \$125.00 on alcohol in the past 30 days and \$400.00 on drugs in the past 30 days. He reports never overdosing on any drugs or alcohol. He reports having used a needle IV to administer drugs and the last time a needle was used was One time when he was 16.. John reports never having had treatment for substance abuse. He says that he has not attended AA/NA/SMART or any other support groups in the past 30 days.

John reports that he has had no days of alcohol-related problems in the past 30 days. He indicated that he is not at all worried or bothered by alcohol problems in the past 30 days. Additionally, he indicated the need for counseling or treatment for alcohol problems as no need.

John reports that he has experienced one day of drug-related problems in the past 30 days. He indicated that he is moderately worried or bothered by drug problems in the past 30 days. The reason for this is "He is moderately worried he is going to mess up and lose his chance at drug court.". Additionally, he indicated the need for counseling or treatment for drug problems as slight need.
